Jaime & Rose Mary Loya Senior Pastors

Jaime Loya was born on December 28, 1974 to Juan and Norma Loya of San Benito,
Texas. He graduated from San Benito High
School in 1993. That same year, in the summer of 1993, he married the love of his life, Rose
Mary Benavides. Soon after marriage, Jaime attended Tell My People Bible Training Center and graduated with the highest GPA of his class. Upon graduation, Jaime & Rose Mary began their ministry as youth pastors at ICCM Tabernacle of Life in Harlingen, Texas.

They continued. working until God moved them to start Valley International Christian Center, now known as Cross Church alongside their parents in 1995.

In 2004. soon after entering their new 600 seat sanctuary, Pastor Jaime Loya was recognized by the National Hispanic Christian Leadership Conference (NHCLC), Third Day Believer's Network (3DBN), and the Hispanic Registry of Who's Who in America as one of the most significant and successful Hispanic pastors in the United States of America. In that year, he also had the distinct honor and privilege of being named and recognized as a Bishop by the Third Day Believer's Network (3DBN).

In 2011 and 2013, VICC was recognized by Outreach Magazine as one of America's 100 Fastest Growing Churches. In 2014, the church entered into their new state-of-the-art facility which seats 1,800 people and includes administrative offices, cafe, a bookstore, and a children's wing.

Pastor Loya's duties include leading a church of over 2,400 people in weekend attendance, employing a full time church staff and developing church leaders. Pastor Loya has also successfully launched several church plants and campuses and is in the process of launching more in the near future. He serves as a mentor and ministry coach to pastors in and around the area.

Pastor Loya is regarded as one of the emerging voices in America and prominent preachers of his generation. His unique style and bilingual speaking ability has taken him all over the nation ministering in some of America's largest churches. He has also ministered abroad in places such as Germany, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Costa Rica and several parts of Central America. Aside from his pastoral duties, he serves as a Board Member of the National Hispanic Leadership Conference (NHCLC) - America's Largest Hispanic Christian Organization leading the way in addressing issues such as poverty, healthcare, education reform, religious persecution, juvenile delinquency, etc.

Jaime and Rose Mary currently reside in the city of Harlingen, Texas and are the proud parents of four children - Hannah, Sarah, Isaiah and Josiah.



"Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart.."



WE STAND FOR GOD'S WORD

At Cross Church, we adhere to the belief and doctrine that God's Word is the final authority on all things. We do not believe it is a suggestion, but sound doctrine for righteous living.

We recognize that our American culture has redefined certain definitions including marriage. At Cross Church, we adhere to a biblical definition of marriage between man and woman. The consistent ideal for sexual experience in the Bible is chastity for those outside a monogamous heterosexual marriage and fidelity for those inside such a marriage.

It should be noted that when it comes to people attending our church, ALL are welcomed.

But, when it comes to serving on our Ministry Serve Team, and serving in Leadership, the standards for righteous living are more closely examined and expected. The Bible makes it clear that we should avoid sexual immorality (1 Thess. 4:1-8). Though God's forgiveness is full and complete, there is a distinction between forgiveness for past sins and necessary biblical suitability for spiritual leadership. 1 Timothy 3 outlines qualifications necessary for those who desire to be spiritual leaders. Those qualifications include being "above reproach" and having a "good reputation."

Lastly, it is critical that those serving in ministry exhibit strong convictions and a lifestyle consistent with biblical standards. A past problem in this area does not necessarily disqualify you, but we believe once saved, your life should display the fruits of the grace imparted in your life.
